This year has been unlike any other but what we have seen in our local church and ministry is that nothing can stop God and his kingdom from advancing. Please take a look at all that Camino de Vida has been able to do despite Peru being under Martial Law since March 2020.

Ministry Overview

This year in Camino de Vida: (since marshall law started on March 15th, 2020)

- Over 211,684 people have been reached & blessed through local outreach programs: Food & clothing distributions, wheelchair distributions, online hotline for the elderly & those dealing with COVID, weekly food distributions for our Kids Club which is our ministry for kids at risk.
- Over 2,394 people have made Jesus their personal Lord & Saviour.
- We have held 1,507 online small groups. About 10+ people attend each group.
- 248 students enrolled in our Leadership Institute, IDL
- 683 people have gone through the online Growth Track class.
- We have held 7 online services (on three platforms - Instagram, Facebook, Youtube) each Sunday for the past 36+ weeks. Our kids ministry, the student ministry, high school/college ministry & young adults ministry have all had online services each week as well as corresponding small groups.
- Grace House (home for girls struggling with addictions) has maintained active this year & is currently entirely online.
- We hosted an online Marriage conference "Amor del Bueno" in which 43,700 people attended from 58 countries.
- We released a Christmas Album, all original songs, & all recorded from peoples homes. We also released an EP made by/sung by the student ministry.

- 21,426 kids received Christmas gifts this year!
- Our pastors have continued to release a new podcast episode each week. This podcast talks about the DNA of our church & helps other churches in and around Latin America.

As ministers at CDV we serve in whatever capacity is needed of us. Apart from serving in the areas listed about, this year we have also been active in the following areas:

- As the director of Missions Paige has maintained the line of communication open with churches that partner with CDV in sending short-term mission teams. This year we have held Virtual Mission Trips as churches have not been able to physically travel to Peru.
- Stalin has taken over the social media for Life Missions, CDVs English part of the church. This is how we actively stay connected with partner churches that come on short-term mission trips.
- Paige is the Physical Education teacher of the Leadership School, IDL, at CDV and has led the 55+ students in online classes in March, not only keeping them active during the 3 month lockdown period but continuing to teach them the importance of staying healthy and active as Christian leaders.
- Stalin is the lead translator for Pastor Al Furey and his wife Kathy. He translates in real time several times a week for Pastor Al during Sunday services as well as meetings & other services during the weekdays.
- We have both been active in leading and attending small groups this year. Online small groups have held our church body together during the pandemic since we were not and still are not able to meet in person.
- Each Sunday CDV holds 7 services on 3 platforms. We are over 1 of those platforms for 1 of the services. Each week we lead a team of volunteers in hosting the service online and doing follow up with those that are new believers, want to take the Growth track class...etc. We also led the Growth track for 2 of the other services. One in English and one in Spanish.
- Stalin is over our Kids Club ministry which is CDVs ministry for kids at risk. Schools have been shut down all year and most kids are not able to get the education they need. Stalin has led a group of volunteers in tutoring these kids over the phone so they don't fall behind in their education. We have also been able to get food to them twice a week during the lockdown.
