2021 ANNUAL REPORT

2021 was the second year of the pandemic in Peru as in the rest of the world. 2020 left us with a different world. Many businesses closed and the economy was greatly impacted as a result of it. Schools and churches, which are a vital aspect of society, remained closed.

People have lost more than jobs and money, they also lost loved ones, not only from Covid. People lost time with their families and friends, there has been so much loss. However, even in the darkest of times The Church has stepped up and has shined light in a world that is hurting and desperate for a word of hope.

Camino de vida, by the grace of God, has become even more influential in Perú and in Latin America. Thousands have been reached through online small groups, online services and our social outreach endeavors. Also thousands of pastors and leaders have been encouraged and equipped through our podcast and online round tables at Hacienda Iglesia.

We, the Solises, are excited and thankful to be part of the team. We are on the mission of helping one of the most influential churches in the world to continue growing and setting the foundations for the next generation. As pastor Robert says we do not believe in generational curses, but generational decisions. So, we are here for the long run building The Church through Camino de vida for generations to come.

Ministry Overview

This year at Camino de Vida:

- 188,467 people have been served through local outreach programs.
- 380 students enrolled in our Leadership Institute, IDL
- 500 people with disabilities were blessed with wheelchairs.
- We have had over 1,350 online small groups. 13,400 in total have been actively participating in these small groups between curriculum based groups and “free themed” groups.
- 1,132+ people gave their lives to Jesus through in person and online services.
- 553 people finished the online Growth Track class.
- We have held 7 online services (on three platforms - Instagram, Facebook, Youtube) each Sunday for the past year and a half. Our kids ministry, the student ministry, high school/college ministry & young adults ministry have all had online services each week as well as corresponding small groups.
- 654 volunteers: served in the 7 unique online Sunday services.
- 665 volunteers: served in the 7 unique in person Sunday services.
- 479 people: connected to our weekly online prayer services through 3 social media platforms.
- 362 kids: connected to small groups each week through our online kids ministry.
- Grace House (home for girls struggling with addictions) has maintained active this year & is currently entirely online. We also launched a new program like Grace House but for men called Grace Refuge. Stalin and Paige are both actively teaching and counseling young men and women through this program. We also
- We had our first online Women's conference.
- We released a new album, all original songs, & called “Ven, Mira de Nuevo.” We have about 30,000 monthly listeners on Spotify.
- We reached 100 episodes in the Hacienda Iglesia podcast. This is a church leadership podcast that seeks to inspire and equip pastors in Latin America to grow their churches and reach the next generation.

As ministers at CDV we serve the vision of our Pastor and church. That often means we wear several different hats. Apart from serving in the areas listed above, this year we have also been active in the following areas:

- Each Sunday CDV holds 7 online services over 3 platforms. We lead 1 of those platforms for 1 of the services. Each week we lead a team of volunteers in hosting the 3:30pm service online and doing follow up with those that are new believers, want to take the Growth track class...etc.
- As the director of Missions Paige has maintained the line of communication open with churches that partner with CDV in sending short-term mission teams. This was her last year as Missions Director. In 2022 she will be transitioning to work with our "Haciendo Iglesia" team.
- Paige is the Physical Education teacher of the Leadership School, IDL, at CDV and has led the 55+ students in online classes, not only keeping them active during the pandemic period but continuing to teach them the importance of staying healthy and active as Christian leaders.
- We have both been active in leading and attending small groups this year. Online small groups have held our church body together during the pandemic since we were not and still are not able to meet in person.
- One of the small groups we had the privilege of teaching together is the class for engaged couples, or "Novios." We taught this class twice in 2021.
- Stalin is over our Kids Club ministry which is CDVs ministry for kids at risk. Schools have been shut down the past two years and most kids are not able to get the education they need. Stalin has led a group of volunteers in tutoring these kids over the phone and most recently in person one day a week, so they don't fall behind in their education.
- Grace House/Grace Refuge: two separate programs for men and women struggling with addictions. These programs are currently still online and Paige and Stalin have been active this year in teaching classes and counseling these men and women each week.
- I7 is our summer internship for teenage students. Stalin has been active in teaching doctrine class to the interns.
